Before then, our spring fund-raiser, in association with the Sedgewood Club, is *Jim Dale: Still Carrying On* at the Sedgewood Boathouse overlooking China Pond on Saturday, June 5 at 8 p.m.

Although known to millions of children as the voice of Harry Potter (Noted in Guinness World Records for 146 different voices for "Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix"), Jim Dale is known to Broadway audiences for "Scapino," "Barnum" – for which he won a Tony Award, "Me and My Girl" and "Joe Egg." He also won an Oscar Nomination for writing the lyrics for the song "Georgy Girl." He starred in twelve of the British "Carry On" films, excerpts of which will be projected on June 5.

Mr. Dale will be introduced by Neil Hickey who, after seeing *Carrying On* at the Paley Center for Media in New York, invited Jim to spend an evening with us reviewing his varied and extraordinary past fifty-five years in show business.

In addition to the performance, there will be dessert, wine, a simple raffle and a chance to socialize.
